Mo Isom, former LSU soccer player and current motivational speaker was raised in Atlanta, GA. As a child, she was raised in a Christian family

and participated in both the sports arena and entertainment industry.

She was heavily recruited out of high school and chose to attend LSU to continue her soccer career.

While at LSU, she earned honors as an All-American goalkeeper and was the first female to train with and try out for an SEC men's football team. She shocked the world by scoring a 90 yard soccer goal and made it onto ESPN SportsCenter's Top 10 with that play.



Her story is one with many tragedies - including battling an eating disorder, overcoming the suicide of her father, struggling with promiscuity, and surviving a horrific car accident. Through these experiences, she found her solid foundation in Jesus and now serves Him by sharing her faith through her books and speaking engagements. She currently lives in Atlanta, GA with her husband, Jeremiah, and their two daughters, Auden and Asher. They are expecting their third child in May 2019!

Greater Chattanooga / Southeast Tennessee Fellowship of Christian Athletes

- FCA has a presence at more than 60 high schools, middle schools, and colleges across the seven counties comprising the Greater Chattanooga/ Southeast Tennessee Area.
- Approximately 4,000 high school, middle school, and college young people are involved with FCA in southeast Tennessee.
- Six full-time staff members (Jay Fowler, Julie Watson, Laura O'Dell, Duvall Young, Hudson Smith, Heath Eslinger) and four part-time staff members (Lori Davis, CJ Cesario, Chad Pyke, Christine Smith) along with a 22-person Leadership Board and numerous volunteers, are responsible for conducting FCA activities in the GC/ST Area.
- Over 1,000 area students and coaches have been involved in special FCA events such as Training Day, Fields of Faith, and a Leadership Breakfast.
- FCA's local budget of \$850,000, which funds staff, programs, activities, and camp scholarships, is raised within the area through donations from individuals, businesses, churches, and foundations.
